Project summary

“Let's be immigrants together” is going to take place near Bari (south east of Italy), one of the first cities in which people from Africa and Asia migrate to.

The project is an Youth Exchange 1.1, from 10th to 17th of may 2014 (7 days of activities), it is focused on the cooperation of youth workers from the EU as well as from Eastern countries partnership, in which 30 young people from 6 countries will explore the topic of migration in Europe.

Integration of migrants as well as the changing of the local society is required.

There are a lot of stories of those who have survived and tried to get in a new Country. Nothing is being done on the local level where the actual people and migrants live, especially in south Italy, the biggest theater of migration for the refugees and for a lot of young migrants with few possibility, for most of them Italy is the first step for European dream.

“Let's be immigrants together” is addressed to youth workers in order to improve their skills and competencies in work with youth.

We want to discuss situation on field of immigration in Europe in participating countries, to learn better as well as to compare the best way to improve the integration of different cultures in local society.

The aims of the project are: knowing more about immigrant; learning the EU immigrant policies and programmes; intercultural communications and experiences; sharing knowledges of each country; provide a general framework of local community; promote European values as integration, solidarity, human rights; widespread the Youth In Action Programme and improving the connection between youngers from several Countries in order to keep the cooperation in this field for new similar projects.

We will make different activities: play games, make exercises, do workshops, make role play games and round-tables; do reflection and outdoor activities.

We will also explore local group dynamic and develop basic skills how to work with group of immigrants to improve the integration, taking part on excursion to share others experience.

We would like to use practice skills and methods we find out as a useful for our work. We mostly use techniques of experiential learning to show principles of non-formal education. We would like to create space for meeting, sharing, discovering and learning.
